

## **2019 VENDOR BOOTH INFORMATION HCRA STATE CHAMPIONSHIP RACE**

First thank you for being a vendor and for supporting HCRA, our hosting association KOA, and the Hanalei community. We are excited to put on an epic event and appreciate you being involved. Here is some basic information you all need to know.

### **When can we set up?**

You may start setting up in your assigned location on Friday morning. There will be no security in the area and you may not stay with your tent so it may be worth setting up your tent/tables and then stocking on Saturday morning.

### **How early can we start on Saturday?**

The gate to the parking area will open at 5:00 a.m.

### **Where do we park?**

The HCRApaddler.com website has event maps. Vendor and official parking are essentially in the lot next to the Pavilion area where you will be selling. So, nice short walk. You may pick up your vendor parking pass on Friday. You will not be allowed in the parking area Saturday without the pass.

### **Easiest way to do our load in?**

You will not have truck access to the tents on Saturday so I'd bring wheels – hand truck, wagon, whatever works best for you.

### **Where is my spot?**

Spots are assigned via the map attached to this info sheet. We had many specific requests and attempted to accommodate as many as we could as far as being on an end spot or next to a particular vendor.

### **If I need power?**

You need to bring it. There is a 10-foot buffer/vendor only zone between the two rows of tents. The goal is to block the ends and give you all some storage/resting space behind your individual tents so you have some room to maneuver. If you require a power source, that would be the best location for it if not too loud – otherwise bring long and a lot of extension cords and put a generator off of the tent area.

### **If I don't want to bring a tent/table?**

### **Who do I see on Friday if I have questions?**

Your primary contact is Keri Mehling at 276-1080. She will have the parking passes you need as well as the master spreadsheet. Backup is Dana Miyake at 925-998-2984. If you need us, we will

be on site from 9 to 5. Please keep in mind that Keri also does all of the merchandise so will be working on that and Dana is on point for all KOA host stuff – so please be patient if it takes a bit for us to respond or we have to break away from something else we are organizing.

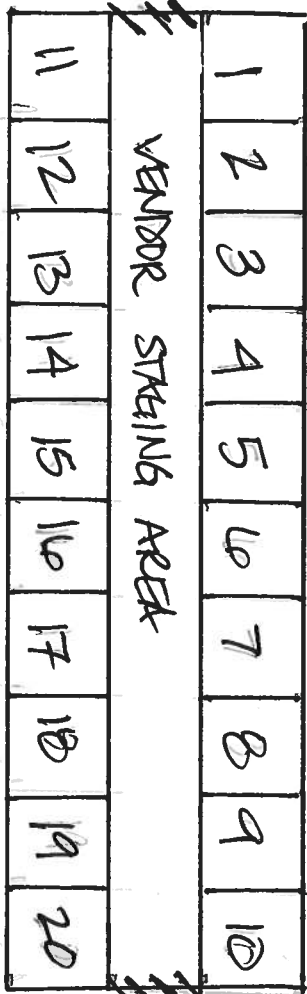
